

## **INFORMATION FOR PRESENTERS**

The oral and poster presentations are intended to familiarize all retreat participants with SFA and related/collaborative research. Equally important, the presentations should stimulate creative discussions during the breakout sessions. As such, it is important that both the oral and poster presentations:

- (1) Describe how the presented topic fits into one of the three SFA Challenges (where applicable);
- (2) Describe recent SFA advances that (where reasonable) emphasize unique SFA competencies;
- (3) Identify opportunities for future research that is specific to the SFA component or method presented. Please think creatively and boldly about these topics, as they will be important for stimulating the long term research discussions. For oral presenters, these ‘new opportunities’ might encompass the last few slides of your presentation. For poster presenters, this topic might encompass the bottom 1/6 of the poster space (see template provided).

### **ORAL PRESENTERS:**

- Some oral presentations will have a paired (or closely related) poster. In those cases, the oral presenters should mention the related posters.
- Oral presenters will have 15 minutes for presentation (with 5 minutes for Q&A and transition)
